Dear brothers and sisters – dear friends,

I'm not in the parish this Sunday since I am in Toronto chairing the annual meeting of the board of Catholic Renewal Ministries Canada, the charitable organization that supports the missionary work of Ralph Martin and his fellow evangelists.

I had hoped to say something to you at Mass to express my deep appreciation for your tremendous support at the time of my mother's death and funeral liturgies. But I didn't trust myself to do that without getting emotional, so I am taking the easy way out by writing to you while I'm absent.

I need to begin by expressing my gratitude to each and every one of you who joined us for Vespers or the Funeral Mass. The large number who attended was a powerful sign of our unity in Christ, and the generous gift of your time meant the world to us. And to all who were involved with those consoling liturgies, including our wonderful choir members and musicians, ministers, dedicated sacristans, flower arrangers, and office staff I owe a great debt. The Mass and vigil prayers—and the church itself—were exceptionally beautiful.

The reception organized by the CWL was exactly what my Mom would have liked, right down to the proper percentage of egg salad sandwiches! The League members have faced an unusual number of funerals lately, yet remain gracious and hospitable in performing this important ministry.

As my mother would have expected of me, I am trying very hard to acknowledge as many of you as possible with a thank-you note. But I am still not close to finished and may have to surrender soon to pre-Christmas pressures. Please know that I am profoundly grateful for the many Masses, lovely cards, flowers, and thoughtful words, even if I don't succeed in writing to you personally.

My Mom was very blessed to be a member of this parish family, and so am I.
