# 'Come away and rest a while'

Although our church is still closed and it's not possible to visit with Jesus in the tabernacle, Christ the Redeemer remains an oasis for prayer, complete with palm trees! We invite you to come here to pray. The Grotto of Our Lady has already been very popular, but we are expanding opportunities for private prayer.

Last year a generous family donated a bench for those waiting to be picked up after Mass. We will now place it in front of the main doors so that one person (or two from the same household) may pray. Scripture verses will be posted on the doors each week, and supplies for sanitizing the bench will be provided.

The statue of Christ the Redeemer at the entrance of the parking lot is also a popular place for a brief prayer.

Wherever you choose to pray, please maintain your distance from others for your safety and theirs.

### OR Code How-To

A QR code is a square image like the one you see here on your left. It functions like a barcode in the sense that it contains information (for example, a website link)

and conveys it quickly when scanned. It can be scanned from any smartphone that has a camera.

To scan a QR code, open your smartphone's camera app and position the QR code image in your camera so that it is focussed. The phone will detect the code and give you an option to click to go directly to the link in your mobile browser (you'll need internet for it to load).

CTR is currently using QR codes for our online offertory (as above), and some registration links.
