Catholic Schools Week

This week is Catholic Schools Week. Did you know that the parish subsidizes St. Thomas Aquinas High School for each student from our parish that attends, and helps provide tuition assistance to families attending STA and St. Anthony's School? These subsidies and tuition assistances help make Catholic Education accessible to all.

For the current school year, CTR is responsible for subsidizing 81 students at STA at \$200 each per year, for a total of \$16,200. The parish is also providing tuition assistance for 5 children at SAS and 6 teens at STA, at a total cost of \$38,950.

Your generosity in today's second collection for Catholic Education greatly helps the parish to ensure that our parish families continue to receive and have access to a Catholic education through one of our local Catholic schools.

In addition to financial support, the parish is also extending our evangelization efforts to proclaim the Gospel and raise up intentional disciples with school parents. The parish is working with STA to offer the Discovery faith studies to school parents, and is running an Alpha for St. Anthony's School parents following Spring Break.
